2011-12 Guidelines

I. Enrollment Requirements

- a. Must be a current freshman, sophomore, junior or senior enrolled at George Washington Carver High School.
- b. Students can only enroll in a course if they failed during a previous academic school year. *Exceptions will be made for students needing credit to graduate in May 2012.*
- c. Students will be required to take the EOCT in May 2012.
- d. Parents must attend an orientation meeting on January 12, 2012. To accommodate parent schedules orientation times will be spaced throughout the day at 9:30am, 12:30pm, 3:30pm, and 5:30pm.

II. 5th Block Calendar

- a. The 5th Block program will be Monday – Friday, 3:30 to 5:45 pm.
- b. Classes begin January 17, 2012 and end April 9, 2012.
- c. All regular school holidays will be observed.

III. Grading Policy

- a. The grade received in Online 5th Block will NOT replace previous failed grade. The course will show on official transcript as a new credit.
- b. Students will be required to take the End-of-Course-Test during the May administration.

IV. Behavior & Attendance Requirements

- a. Students must follow all rules outlined in the George Washington Carver High School Student Handbook and the Muscogee County School District Behavior Code and Discipline Policy. Any behavior issues will result in immediate dismissal from the program.
- b. Due to the extent of the required seat time as outlined by Muscogee County School District students will be allowed 4 unexcused absences before dismissal from program.

V. Transportation

- a. Bus transportation is pending for 5th Block and will be decided upon before January 12th parent meeting.
- b. Parents should pick students up within 15 minutes of program dismissal.
