**Online Extended Semester Credit Recovery (OESCR)**  
2011-2012 Guidelines

I. Enrollment Requirements

- a. The purpose of **OESCR** is to give students extended time to meet course requirements. Students can only have extended time from a course taken Fall 2011 at George Washington Carver High School.
- b. Students must have a current class average of **65 to 69**.
- c. To extend time students must receive permission from the teacher of record to be given extended time to master course requirements.

II. Extended Year Calendar

- a. Online Extended Semester Credit Recovery will begin **January 12, 2012** and end **January 27, 2012**. The program will be **Monday – Friday, 3:30 to 5:45 pm** at George Washington Carver High School.
- b. The MLK Holiday will be observed.

III. Grading Policy

- a. Students will receive a grade of Incomplete (I) on their first semester report card.
- b. Students who successfully meet course requirements will receive a final grade of **70**.

IV. Behavior & Attendance Requirements

- a. Students must follow all rules outlined in the George Washington Carver High School Student Handbook and the Muscogee County School District Behavior Code and Discipline Policy. Any behavior issues will result in immediate dismissal from the program.
- b. Regular attendance is encouraged as students will be given a maximum of 22 hours to show mastery of deficient standards.

V. Transportation

- a. Students must provide their own transportation for Online Extended Semester Credit Recovery.
- b. Parents should pick students up within 15 minutes of program dismissal.
